Skylar had the heart of a servant and a smile as bright as the sun.

The scholarship offers one \$500 scholarship award to a qualifying KidsQuest student every year that embodies the same servant, leader heart that Skylar had. Scholarship funds can be used for school supplies or saving towards further education. A designated committee of NIYC leadership representatives will make the selection.

Eligibility & Award Criteria

To be eligible to receive a Reach for the Sky Scholarship, students must meet all of the following criteria:

1. Be enrolled at an elementary or middle school
2. Be an active member of their church's children's ministry
3. Be a United States citizen or permanent resident of the U.S.

In addition to the application, please provide the following supporting materials:

1. Two letters of recommendation, one from your pastor or children's church leader and another from a person who can speak about your servant's heart.
